Dear Parents/Carers,

We are pleased to be able to offer our children the chance to participate in a variety of different afterschool clubs this term - please read through the list of clubs below. To sign your child up for their preferred after school clubs please log on to your child's ParentPay account and make a payment against the club/s you wish your child to attend.

Payment for after school clubs can be made either in full or in instalments.

Clubs will start the week beginning **Monday 25th April 2022** and end for this term on the week beginning **Monday 11th July 2022**.

If you do need any assistance with booking your child's after school club place, please contact the school office as soon as possible as spaces are limited.

Martial Arts – Monday

This will be run by an experienced coach from Teach Sport Greenwich. Children will learn a variety of martial arts skills and a black belt attitude which will help them reach any goal they set their minds to. Classes are taught in a fun and motivating way helping to improve confidence, self-motivation and fitness.

Gardening – Monday

We are pleased to give our children the opportunity to participate in a new exciting Gardening after school club which will be run by Miss Davidson. This club will encourage the children to develop their interest and knowledge of gardening along with planting seeds to grow their own flowers and vegetables.

Multi-sport – Tuesday

This club will be run by our Sports, Health and Wellbeing leader Mr O'Regan. He specialises in many sports and regularly works with the children during PE lessons and at break times. Children will get to try out a variety of different sports during these sessions which will help children to improve their fitness, coordination and team work skills.

Choir – Tuesday

Behaviour Expectations
