As the weeks fly by, we are beginning to notice that the weather is cooling down and the rain is appearing, but it won't stop any of us here at school from getting on with our fun as usual. Please can we ask that children are prepared with jumpers/cardigans and waterproof coats so that they don't have to miss out on their breaktimes due to the weather. And, as always, please make sure these are named!



Let's take a look at some of the exciting learning from this week.

Year 1 have continued to work very hard across all areas of learning. In maths, the children have been using their reasoning skills to solve problems. They particularly enjoyed using their digital skills to complete activities in Purple Mash. Mateus said, 'I'm so excited because this is the first time I'm using IPads in Year



1!' In English, the children have used drama techniques to explore the characters emotions and feelings. Douglas wrote, 'I think Beegu is feeling devastated because she wants to return home to her mum and dad.' In addition, Year 1 have absolutely loved their PE sessions with Mr O'Regan. Ishmael has continuously said, 'I love doing PE with Mr O'Regan.' It's very impressive how well the children have settled in Year 1 and how resilient they all are.

Year 3 have been building on their French language learning by exploring different types of food they have in France! Mrs Cook and Mrs Vdovin saw this lesson and were very impressed by the children's knowledge! River said 'I enjoy French, I have been excited to do this in year 3'. The children have also

been showing a growth mindset in their maths, by comparing 2-digit numbers. Emily explains that this week in reading year 3 are learning about the skill inference, 'Inferring helps me understand and unlock the authors secrets' she explains, as they have been enjoying their new whole class reading text 'James and the Giant Peach'. In English, they have been writing about animals and expanding their vocabulary in order to write some creative noun phrases to describe an animal based on their core text, 'the Hunter', 'an elephant is a noble, loyal creature' shares Elaina.





Year 5 has had an excellent start to the year. It has been wonderful to watch the children settle into their new year group, and watch new and old friendships flourish. They have immersed themselves into our new core text 'A long walk to water,' and have loved reading about their two characters, Salva and Nya, within the split narrative. Jessica has especially loved reading our daily chapters, 'I hate it when we are left on a cliff hanger, I just want to keep on reading more!' The children have also gained a new found confidence when working with decimal numbers in maths, and have thoroughly enjoyed



ordering decimal and whole numbers in a sequence. An extra special part of the half term has been the addition of swimming to their weekly timetable. Mrs Clifford is very proud of year 5 for trying their



best, and despite some worries around swimming, all children have given it a go. Mrs Clifford is confident that she will see lots of positive, strong swimmers amongst her class over the year. When asked about the best part of their week on Friday, most children agreed that swimming was their highlight.

We are looking forward to seeing what the rest of the term has in store for year 5, Year 3 and Year 1!
