We are very excited to share with you all that this year, we will be having food fortnight across the school. Over the two weeks, the children will have DT (Design and Technology) focused lessons where they will work towards creating a dish inspired by a chosen culture. In doing this, we want to celebrate what makes the adults and children in our school community unique. At the end of the two weeks, the children will showcase their learning by contributing to Rockcliffe's infamous World Café.

This year our World Café will take place on **Friday 14th October 2022**. For those of you who are new to Rockcliffe, World Cafe is when parents, staff and children bring in a chosen dish representing a particular culture, this is shared by the children in the afternoon and parents are also invited to the World Café after school, around 3.30pm, to celebrate the diversity in our community.

It will also be a non-school uniform day where children will be able to wear clothing that represents their culture, who they are or a group that they belong to. Some examples would be a Brownie uniform, traditional dress or a sports kit. Each child will have the opportunity to explain the outfit they are wearing and why it is so special to them through class fashion shows.
