

Year 4's learning this half term:

English

In English, this half term Year 4 will be reading our core text 'Who let the gods out'. We will be using this book and our previous knowledge of last terms core text to understand Greek mythology. We will use the story to create our own recount narrative from the perspective of one of the characters from the story.

During the Autumn 2 term, the children will learn how Ancient Greece



History

was the founding father of debate and democracy. The children will research who were the key figures in Ancient Greece and understand how democracy was created and used in their time. As debate was a crucial tool used by poorer sections of society in Ancient Greece to dispute their living conditions, children will study the concept of activism and the role that protests have in society. They will work towards supporting junior leadership teams within school to create a mediation team that will lead on settling disputes within and beyond school.

Maths

In Maths, this half term Year 4 will be focusing on measurement at the beginning of the term. The children will learn how to find the area of different shapes. The children will then move on to multiplication and division for the rest of the half term. They will learn their times tables and use them to help them in dividing numbers.

<u>Science</u>

In Science, we will be learning all about Electricity through identifying and exploring different appliances around the school. We will be designing and creating simple circuits that will incorporate the different components. We will explore questions: What is the difference between an insulator and conductor? What could prevent a circuit from working? These are all questions we will explore in this exciting topic to improve our understanding.



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RE

In RE, Year 4 are learning about the religion of Christianity. We will be examining the laws and rules followed in the religion and the importance of the Church and the Bible for Christians. We will use RE artefacts to explore the importance of certain objects in the Christian religion.

PE

In PE, the children will be developing their fundamental movement skills during their Multi-skills lessons. They will also continue to take part in the Welling United Wellness Wings programme.

RSE

In RSE, the children will be exploring how community works. They will explore different communities and how they can be a part and make a change within one.

French

In French children will be learning to verbally practising to tell the time.

General Information

PE: Please make sure children bring their PE kits on the days that they have PE. They should have suitable clothing and footwear for both indoor and outdoor PE. As it's getting colder, the children should wear trousers instead of shorts.

It has been so lovely to see so many children reading with parents at home and earning their reading certificates. Please continue to read at home with your child.

Times Tables: As part of the class 'Times Tables Challenge' the class will be practicing all of their times tables up to 12. It would be great for them to also practice these times tables at home.
